Flights usually include 1 carry-on bag and 1 checked bag. Weight limit for the checked bag is 50 pounds, its best to weigh your bag at home and be 5 pounds light. Traveling with fishing gear is always hit or miss airport to airport so I recommend putting your fishing gear in your checked bag.
